Camp Routines to Remember: Daily Needs

No crocs and no flip flops at school

Each day, please send in a towel, bathing suit, change of clothes and shoes. Children should have appropriate shoes here at all times. We need both active shoes and pool shoes every day. Please send in a pair of shoes each day that can be safely fastened such as sneakers or sandals that have both heel and toe straps and good sturdy soles. For poolside, please send in water shoes. Please send sunscreen in at the beginning of your camp session. Any remainder will be returned to you on your child's last day. Each day, please apply sunscreen before your child comes to camp and we will re-apply as necessary throughout the day. Be sure to let staff know if your child arrives without sunscreen.

Snacks will be provided by the school. Campers will be making a special snack each week as well. Children staying the full day should bring lunch from home.

Half day and full day children arrive and dismiss using the drive up process at the door. Camp with care and 12-month contracted families will walk-in with their children, sign in at the table, out their belongings away and meet the teacher at the blue wall. These children must be signed in and out every day,
