Camp Routines to Remember: Daily Needs

The following items need to be at school every day. You are welcomed to bring them at the beginning of the week and leave them here. We will send things home on Fridays or as they get soiled.

A bath-sized towel, bathing suit, change of clothes, water shoes and active play shoes (sneakers or sandals which are securely fastened to the foot, front and back). Sorry, no flip flops and no crocs at school. **Please label everything.**

Please send sunscreen in at the beginning of your camp session. Any remainder will be returned to you on your child's last day. Each day, please apply sunscreen before your child comes to camp and we will re-apply as necessary throughout the day. Be sure to let staff know if your child arrives without sunscreen.

Snacks will be provided by the school throughout the day. Campers will also make a special snack each week. Children staying the full day should bring lunch from home.

There is a drive up arrival process at 9 am each day. (8:55 to 9:05) Children arriving at any other time should be walked in and signed in at the piano.

All children will have walk-in dismissals as there are few common schedules this year to facilitate a drive-up dismissal process. Please walk in, sign your child out on the clipboard which is located on the table to the right of the piano, and check your mail folder every afternoon. The mail folders are kept in a turquoise binder on the sign out table.
