We will be renting picnic tables to share while we are there. The only cost is \$3 per person. Children and adults are the same rate and can be paid at the entry shack. You will receive a stamp before entering the beach area. In addition, there is a boat launch but I don't believe motorized boats are allowed on Oxford Furnace Lake. Please be sure that the children have whatever you would like for them at the beach. Deer Path Camp will be providing both a morning snack at school and one at the lake. Please bring anything else that you would like and stay as long as you like at the lake. There is a snack shack available from 11:30 to 5:30 serving pizza, burgers, dogs and ice cream novelties, ranging from \$1 -\$3. I have left messages to a few Deer Path families who live in the immediate area inviting them to join us. You are welcomed to bring guests on this outing as everyone is responsible for their own needs.

The children may arrive at the same time on Thursday. A parent or other authorized driver should return @ 10:30 to the front door. We will load up and caravan together to Oxford Furnace Lake, Kaufman St., Oxford.

Directions: Take Route 46 West to Route 31 South (left at the light. Continue into Oxford. Immediately after the light in Oxford, make a right immediately behind the convenient store onto Kent St. Take to the stop sign. Turn left onto Washington Ave. Then take the next right onto Academy St. (County Route 635) Kaufman St. is the first right, right in front of St. Rose of Lima church. The lake is at the end of the right. Park in the lot to the left.

Be sure that there is a bath-sized towel, bathing suit, change of clothes and water shoes available for your child. Children should also have shoes appropriate for active play every day. There are no flip flops and no crocs at school. Please send sunscreen in at the beginning of your camp session. Any remainder will be returned to you on your child's last day. Each day, please apply sunscreen before your child comes to camp and we will re-apply as necessary throughout the day. Be sure to let staff know if your child arrives without sunscreen. Snacks will be provided by the school. Campers will be making a special snack each week as well. Children staying the full day should bring lunch from home. Half day and full day children arrive and dismiss using the drive up process. Camp with Care and 12-month families use the walk-in process for signing their children in and out every day. If you have any last minute camp needs, please just call the office and let us know, or send in a note with your needs. Additional fees will be due on Monday of that week.
